9.1 Residential Swimming Pools

The construction, installation, maintenance, or repair of swimming pools, whirlpools, hot tubs, and all related accessories for residential structures. A license is required when the value exceeds \$7,500. Residential swimming pools is a subclassification of Residential Construction.



Introduction

Residential Swimming Pools is a closed book examination with 50 multiple-choice questions and a minimum passing score of 70.

You will have 2 hours to complete this examination.
